I encourage all growers, Novice and Experienced growers alike, to enter their orchids in the Show. You may have the next show champion sitting in your greenhouse, however "You'll never never know if you never never show."

The 5th New Growers Workshops will be held at Dennis & Ros's residence (120 Wainai Rd, Farleigh) on Saturday 19th June. The workshop will focus on various methods of watering and fertilizing your orchid collection. Watering is one of the hardest subjects to master with orchid growing.

The North Queensland Orchid Fair was conducted over the weekend and it was highly successful. It was very pleasing to see the happy smiling faces of the general public as they shopped and bought their next champions with choices of many flowering orchids, seedlings and orchid flasks. PEST CONTROL - HOME REMEDY (For all plants, including Orchids): Supplied by Doug Penningh


*500 MLS luke-warm water

*5 MLS Pariffin Oil

*3-4 drops of dishwashing liquid (I use Morning Fresh)

I only spray early morning or late afternoon, never in the heat of the day. This mixture has been very effective on all plants, ferns and especially the orchids (dens, cats, oncids & phallys).

It stops RED SPIDER, WHITEFLY, SCALE & MEALY BUGS. The best of it is, it's not poisonous!
