PRESIDENTS REPORT – AUGUST 2022

Winter seems to have been around for a number of weeks this year when compared to the last few years. The last few Winters usually only lasted 1 or 2 days where a coat or cardigan was required. One of the benefits for an orchid grower of having a cold and longer Winter will be the excellent colour displayed in the Spring flowering season. The colours will be vibrant with the reds, purples and darker colours displaying deeper shades, and the whites and yellows should be very clear and distinctive.

The MDOS Spring Show is scheduled for Friday 7th & Saturday 8th of October with the set-up commencing at noon on Thursday 6th. Plants should be tabled between noon and 2:30pm with the judging commencing at 3:00pm. Take the time now to ensure the plants that are in spike or are displaying flower sheeves have ample space around them, so the flower spikes and inflorescences are not in danger of being tangled or caught a leaf of a nearby plant etc. With Dendrobiums, consider how you are going to stake the flower inflorescence. With Cattleyas, do any of the leaves on the plant require tying back to ensure the flowers are not impeded when opening, does each of the flower buds have room to open next to each other without being crushed together. Trevor Heitman and Doug Penningh will share their ideas and methods they use in plant presentation in preparation for an up-coming show at the August General Meeting.

Remember, if you remove a plant from the bench the plant must be placed back on the bench in the same orientation as previous to ensure the flowers open correctly, the inflorescence is straight and not twisted etc. I find the easiest method in achieving this is by taking note where the pot label is placed in relation to a clock face i.e. the label is positioned at say 4:00 o'clock. The plant can be removed from the bench to complete any staking requirements etc. and placed back on the bench so the label is at 4:00pm.

The rescheduled annual Farleigh Palm Fete is on Sunday August 21st 8:00am to 1:00pm. The Bowen Orchid and Foliage Society Spring Show is on September 17th & 18th, opening times are Saturday 10:00am to 5:00pm and Sunday 8:00am to 2:00pm.

Growers Tip

RAID Oneshot is good for controlling Dendrobium Beetles & Slugs. If you have a problem with ants, put some **ANTRID** on a plastic label and place it in the ants' pathway.

PEST CONTROL - HOME REMEDY (For all plants, including Orchids): Supplied by Doug Penningh

 *3-4 drops of dishwashing liquid (I use Morning Fresh)

I only spray early morning or late afternoon, never in the heat of the day. This mixture has been very effective on all plants, ferns and especially the orchids (dens, cats, oncids & phallys).

It stops RED SPIDER, WHITEFLY, SCALE & MEALY BUGS. The best of it is, it's not poisonous!

Lecture Program:

The lecture program continues to be fine-tuned as we get closer to the conference, but we recently received some very exciting news. Fred Clarke, of Sunset Valley

Orchids in San Diego, California, U.S.A. will be able to join us, and has two very interesting topics to share with registrants: Today's Mini and Compact Cattleyas and Becoming an 80 Percentile Grower. Those of you who haven't had the pleasure of attending one of Fred's lectures before are in for a treat. He is a very charismatic and engaging speaker, who passionately shares his knowledge and love of orchids with whomever will listen. Those of you who have heard Fred speak before know that you can expect sessions full of fun and information.

Fred has been growing orchids for 42 years and has been hybridizing for 38 of those years. Developing Cattleya hybrids has been his sustaining interest during this time, but he is also actively creating new Paphiopedilum and Aussie Dendrobium hybrids. His pioneering work in Catasetum intergeneric hybrids led to the development of several notable hybrids, including *Fredclarkeara* After Dark, which produced "the blackest flower ever witnessed".
