PRESIDENTS REPORT – FEBRUARY 2023

It is with a heavy heart and great sadness to announce the passing of Gina Fitzgibbon on Saturday February 4th. Gina was a long term MDOS member and was our hostess for a number of years before relocating to Brisbane to be near her family. Gina will be sorely missed by her family and all her friends.

Thirty members attended the lectures by Charles Lee and Trevor Heitman at the Senior Citizens Hall. The first lecture was presented by Charles Lee, Charles is a member of the Ayr Orchid & Allied Plant Society and the Townsville Orchid Society. Charles' PowerPoint presentation on greenhouse construction was very well presented and extremely thought provoking. Roz and I have built a number of greenhouses over our orchid growing years, however there were a number of ideas contained in Charles' presentation I haven't even considered. The lecture certainly generated a number of questions. Charles also had a few examples of double potted orchids to keep the root system cool in hot climates on display, he explained this concept to the attentive attendees.

The second lecture was presented by Trevor Heitman on Pest Management, this is the same lecture Trevor provided at the TQOC Conference. His presentation was also well received by the attendees, they took great interest in Trevor's exhibits which contained laminated insect strips which Trevor had used to identify what insects were present in his greenhouse, therefore providing Trevor with the information needed to work out the life cycle of the pest and what treatment is required to eliminate the pest from his collection.

At the next General Meeting on February 16th, Doug Penningh will discuss the advantages of using predatory mites instead of chemicals to control Spider Mite and other insects in your orchid collection and greenhouse. Doug has successfully used beneficial insects for over 12 months.

A bark and charcoal order will be placed in the last week of February. The charcoal sizes are 5mm, 15mm and 20mm. The 5 & 15mm is in 19kg bags while the 20mm is in 10kg bags. The cost of the charcoal has risen to \$50 per 19kg bag and \$25 per 10kg bag.

The 20 raffle plants for the February General Meeting have been sourced from Kingfisher Orchids Nursery at Kholo outside of Ipswich. Ros and I were very happy with the quality and size of the plants when we received them.

PEST CONTROL - HOME REMEDY (For all plants, including Orchids): Supplied by Doug Penningh

*500 MLS luke-warm water

*5 MLS Paraffin Oil

*3-4 drops of dishwashing liquid (I use Morning Fresh)

I only spray early morning or late afternoon, never in the heat of the day. This mixture has been very effective on all plants, ferns and especially the orchids (dens, cats, oncids & phallys).

It stops **RED SPIDER**, **WHITEFLY**, **SCALE** & **MEALY BUGS**. The best of it is, it's not poisonous!
