# **PRESIDENTS REPORT – JUNE 2022**

To ensure the 53<sup>rd</sup> TQOC Conference is a success we need VOLUNTEERS to donate their time during set-up on Thursday afternoon June 30<sup>th</sup> to arrange the show and vendor tables layout; during plant registration and judging on Friday July 1st; and during the conference July 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> as Ushers, Door Attendants, Ticket Sellers, Show Security etc. The planning committee have worked tirelessly over the last 2 years to ensure the conference is a success.

The conference Early Bird offer for MDOS members to attend as a registrant is still available.

The planning committee are happy to announce two world class speakers, Jim Cootes and Gary Yong Gee, who are included in the lecture program to complement 5 other lecturers at the conference. Jim Cootes has travelled extensively throughout New Guinea and the Philippines studying orchids in the wild and is an expert in Australasian and Philippines Dendrobiums and in Australasian and Philippines Bulbophyllums. Bulbophyllum Cootesii is named after Jim Cootes. Gary Yong Gee travels the world lecturing and photographing orchids, he specialises in species orchids and has written a regular monthly article for the *Orchid Species Bulletin* for approximately 35 years.

With the influx of new members over the past 12 months it is timely to explain to new members that the First Flowering section at the monthly general meetings is for first flowering seedlings i.e. the first time that that plant has flowered. It is NOT the first time that a member has flowered it in their greenhouse unless it is a seedling. A plant must be in the possession of and grown by the member for three (3) months.

The editor lists the names of the of the monthly Popular Vote placegetters in Orchidwise. Where the plant genre has changed, or a hybrid has a registered name or the orchid name is spelt incorrectly, the correct name is inserted with an \* at the end of the name. Members are advised to correct the name tag for future reference.

The next New Growers Workshop will be held at Ron Bassan's residence, 6 Harveys Road Beaconsfield, commencing at 2:00pm. The subject matter is how to interpret an orchid label and the correct method to write an orchid label. Please bring your own chair. While there take the opportunity to view the large range of Catasetums that Ron grows.

#### PEST CONTROL - HOME REMEDY (For all plants, including Orchids): Supplied by Doug Penningh

\*500 MLS luke-warm water \*5

\*5 MLS Paraffin Oil

\*3-4 drops of dishwashing liquid (I use Morning Fresh)

I only spray early morning or late afternoon, never in the heat of the day. This mixture has been very effective on all plants, ferns and especially the orchids (dens, cats, oncids & phallys).

It stops RED SPIDER, WHITEFLY, SCALE & MEALY BUGS. The best of it is, it's not poisonous!
