PRESIDENTS REPORT – JUNE 2023

The next New Growers Workshop will be held at Rosalyn & Dennis Farlow residence, 120 Wainai Road, Farleigh, commencing at 10am on Saturday June 24th. A BBQ will be held following the workshop. Bring a chair, something for the raffle table and something for dessert.

It is high time for a review of how the Popular Vote at our General Meeting operates given the influx of new members attending the general meetings. Each category is separated by a white wooden divider, on the left-hand side of the category is a book of tickets and on the right-hand side of the category is a container to hold the tickets. There are different coloured tickets for each category, please use that coloured ticket for that category. The member writes the orchid number they select for that category on the ticket and places the ticket in the container on the right side of the category. The Members Choice vote is a separate slip of paper upon which the member writes the orchid number and the Category for orchid that the member selects as the best orchid at the meeting. The Members Choice voting paper slip is available at the First Flowering end of the tables. The completed voting slip is placed in a separate bucket usually on the end of the tables where the Any Other Genera category is located.

In an attempt to speed up the counting of the Popular Vote, we are going to trial a method which will make locating the name of the orchids which receive votes a lot easier. Members who are tabling plants at the meeting will be handed the right amount numbered labels for the number of plants they table at the meeting. These numbered labels will be numbered sequentially, please write these numbers down sequentially on the Plant Entry forms. Doing so will greatly assist in identifying the orchids which have been voted 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category.

Part of MDOS's charter is to encourage and assist our members to become excellent orchid growers, with this goal in mind we have developed a suggested fertiliser, insecticide and fungicide program which will be explained over the next 2 General Meetings.

Growers Tip

RAID Oneshot is good for controlling Dendrobium Beetles & Slugs. If you have a problem with ants, put some **ANTRID** on a plastic label and place it in the ants' pathway.

PEST CONTROL - HOME REMEDY (For all plants, including Orchids): Supplied by Doug Penningh

*500 MLS luke-warm water

*5 MLS Paraffin Oil

*3-4 drops of dishwashing liquid (I use Morning Fresh)

I only spray early morning or late afternoon, never in the heat of the day. This mixture has been very effective on all plants, ferns and especially the orchids (dens, cats, oncids & phallys).

It stops **RED SPIDER**, **WHITEFLY**, **SCALE & MEALY BUGS**. The best of it is, it's not poisonous!
