This unseasonal wet weather provides a perfect environment for fungus and bacteria to take hold in your collection. Spray with a contact and/or a systemic fungicide i.e. Mancozeb and/or Anti Rot etc.

PEST CONTROL - HOME REMEDY (For all plants, including Orchids): Supplied by Doug Penningh

*500 MLS luke-warm water *5 M

*5 MLS Paraffin Oil

*3-4 drops of dishwashing liquid (I use Morning Fresh)

I only spray early morning or late afternoon, never in the heat of the day. This mixture has been very effective on all plants, ferns and especially the orchids (dens, cats, oncids & phallys).

It stops RED SPIDER, WHITEFLY, SCALE & MEALY BUGS. The best of it is, it's not poisonous!
