The orchids are certainly loving the rains that continue to fall around the region. This year is shaping up to be a bumper year for the Society with a number of issues in the wings. The committee are presently revising the MDOS Constitution and By-Laws. More on that later once the committee finalise the revised draft.

Commencing the last Thursday of January, Arthur Pinkney and a few other judges will be conducting an Australian Orchid Council judging course. We have approximately 8 starters to undertake the course. The course is still open if other members wish to take the course. I was a member of Mount Isa Orchid Society when I commenced the judging course back in the 90's, six of us completed the course by correspondence under the training of Ted & Sylvia Rielly from Cairns. The main reason I did the course was to know what constituted a quality orchid, plus to understand the family heritage of the awarded orchids which then led me to seek out those breeding lines of the award winners to accumulate a quality orchid collection.

Treasurer's Report

Read by Eve Penningh

General Business:

• K. Waddington made a statement to say, "the constitutions were great; however, a lot of work went into them and they should be sent online." It was explained that they are sent online when members join, however MDOS decided to give every member a chance to receive one if they did not get one. He also stated the numbers were down at the shows. This was explained by E. Penningh, that the numbers were about the same at every show. He also suggested that signs for the show are placed in appropriate places. This will be discussed at the next

committee meeting. Also discussed was the advertising for shows. Our Media person ensures that most of the Face Book places and radio stations are met. This will also be discussed at the next committee meeting. K. Waddington also brought up about being a novice. A novice is a new grower who has joined the society, after 3 years will be made up to open. If you Joined 7/21 then you will be made up to open at the AGM in October, as the Society year is from October to September. Not the normal financial Year from July to June.

• P. Milward said a big thank you to MDOS for the New Growers Day 11th November at the Farlow's residence. Thank you, P. Milward. P. Milward also asked if the new grower could be told how to look after these plants in the upcoming months. New members were shown how to unpot their orchids and then shown what roots to cut off and then placed into hormone mixture and then how to re pot. This was not a money- making exercise. 20 new growers attended and 9 experienced growers. There was a lot of laughter and chatting and banter. A new grower said that she felt so confident that she started to pot her own orchids. This is what the society wants to hear.

T. Heitman gave a talk on this. He said "in his years of growing orchids this was the best event he has been to. Everyone was willing to listen and try their hand at repotting."

His suggestions for keeping these alive over the next couple of hot months is:

They have been placed in the growth hormone already.

Don't place in the sun.

When watering: they are wet. Let them dry out then water again. The thing that kills orchids is too much water. Next couple of weeks give the orchids a high Nitrogen fertiliser.

In the new year start to give them a high "k" fertiliser.

Don't wet the crown of the plant. Wet the pot not the crown as this will rot the plant.

- Could we have a talk about sunlight. T. Heitman answered this. You don't place your orchids in direct sunlight as
 this will burn the leaves. If they are in too dark a place, they will not flower. It is a trial-and-error strategy.
 Members will have to keep moving these around until they find the right place. Maybe get in touch with your
 buddy to find out more.
- What is the best medium to use. This was explained that the experienced growers all use different medium, so it is up to you to use what you prefer. Get the advice from your buddy.
- D. Farlow gave a presentation on the Buddy System. It was explained that new growers need to request to be allocated a Buddy to be placed in the system. 3 Novice/New Growers requested to be added to the system at the end of the meeting.
